

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU'RE AFRAID

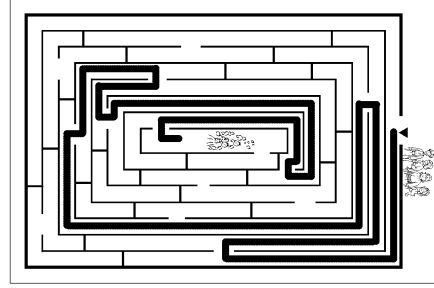
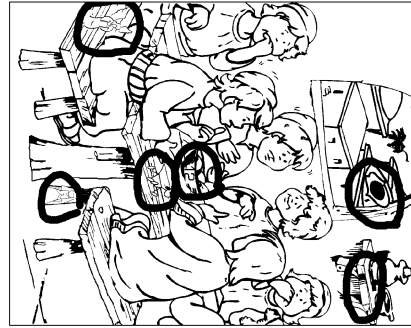

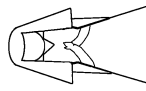
