Nobody knew what to think of that.

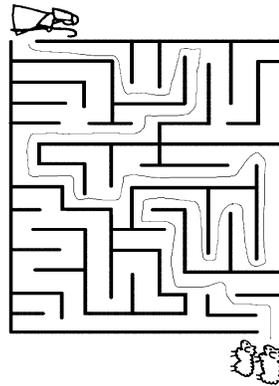

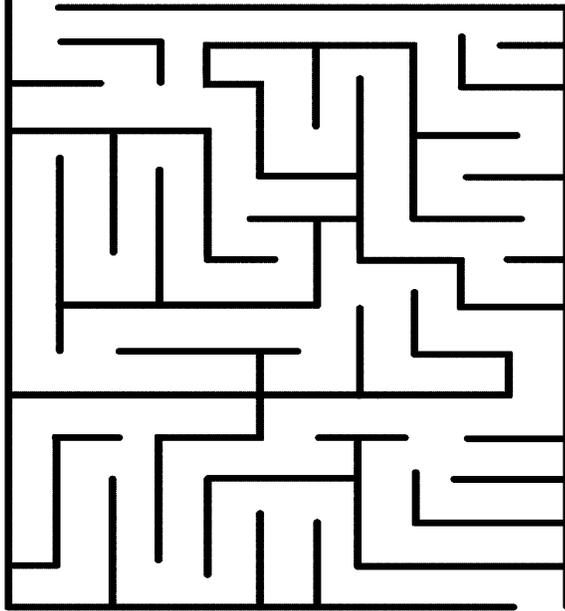
