

THREE NAMES FOR GOD

(Jerusalem) — Jesus' followers, the twelve disciples, learned to think of God in three ways. They had always known that God was like a king or ruler. When Jesus came to be with them he told them that God was not only like a king but more like a good father.



As they learned from Jesus, the disciples learned to know that God was speaking to them through Jesus too. Jesus called himself God's Son. Sometimes Jesus would tell them, "When you see me you have seen my Father."

A third way the disciples learned to think of God was as a Holy Spirit. They could not see the Holy Spirit, but they knew that God was with them in that way because Jesus had promised he would send the Spirit.

We have three names for God.




