

WHO IS YOUR NEIGHBOR?

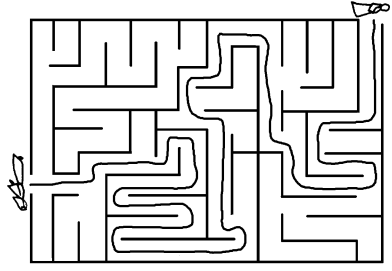
(On the way to Jerusalem) — Jesus taught many things to the people in the crowds that gathered around him. One of the most important things he taught was that we need to love each other.

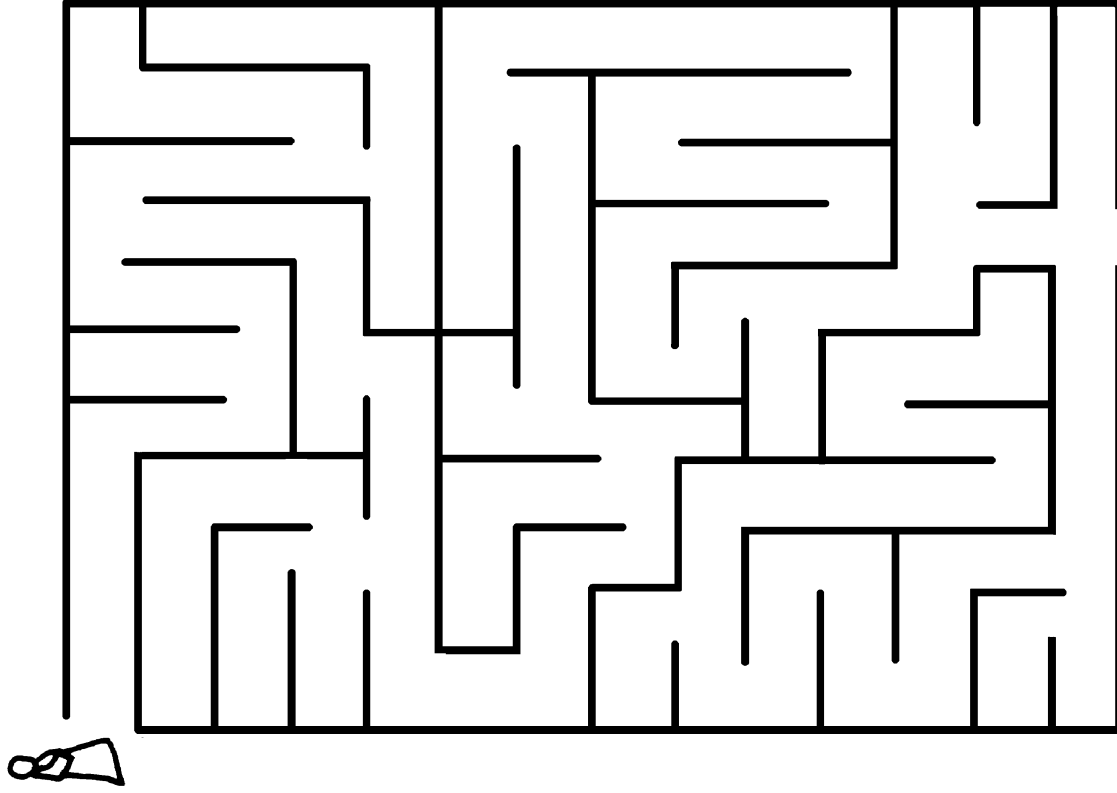
