

DON'T GIVE UP TRUSTING IN GOD


(On the way to Jerusalem) — When people came to listen to Jesus teach, they were amazed at what he told them. But some of the people who heard him teach wondered if they could really trust and believe in what Jesus said.

Jesus said we need to trust God with our lives. We need to believe that God will give us the good things we need. If we trust God to do good things for us, God promises to do them.

Jesus told a story about how much we should trust God to give us the help we need. He said a woman begged a judge to help her when she needed help. The woman asked for the right thing, but the judge didn't have the time to help her. She did not give up. She begged and begged until he gave her what she needed.


